## **ORDER**

# WHEREAS:

- On May 8, 2014 Prokam Enterprises Ltd. (Prokam) filed an appeal from the April 14, 2014 decision of the British Columbia Vegetable Marketing Commission approving a delivery allocation transfer on condition that the designated agency must be BCfresh and not Island Vegetable Cooperative Association (IVCA) as requested by the appellant.
- Prokam confirmed the withdrawal of the appeal in an e-mail dated May 20, 2014.
- Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, SBC 2004, c. 45 provides that if an appellant withdraws an appeal, the tribunal must order that the appeal is dismissed.

## THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:
