



5.17 Out-of-Jurisdiction Rescue Reimbursement Schedule

All Found Rate	<p>General road rescues are reimbursed at \$409/hour with a 1 hour minimum. Past an hour, time is billed at 15-minute increments, rounded to the nearest quarter hour up or down. The rate includes the first 150 km round trip.</p> <p>Rates are applicable from the time of the response vehicle's departure from quarters (point of housing for the response vehicle) and continue until return to quarters.</p> <p>The minimum rate applies to the task, not to multiple trips within a task.</p>
Additional Fire Suppression Vehicle	<p>In a road rescue incident where a Type 1 Structure Engine is required to suppress fire, it may be reimbursed separately from the All Found Rate.</p> <p>If a Type 1 Structure Engine vehicle is approved for reimbursement, the reimbursement rate will be \$717/ hour.</p>
Clean up Rate	<p>A quarter of an hour (15 minutes) at the All Found Rate, is added for clean up when rescue services are rendered.</p> <p>This rate is not added to calls where rescue services were cancelled while on the way, or not required upon arrival.</p>
Consumable Supplies	<p>When rescue services are rendered, \$80/task is added for consumable supplies.</p> <p>The consumable supplies allowance is intended to cover the cost of items such as personal protection equipment (gloves and masks), flashlight batteries, flares and absorbent routinely consumed in a rescue.</p> <p>This rate is not added to calls where the rescue services were cancelled while on the way, or not required upon arrival.</p>
