Executive Summary

Emily Carr University remains focused to reducing its carbon footprint and continues its commitment to implementing environmentally responsible practices.

In 2006, Emily Carr signed the Talloires Declaration, joining a worldwide movement to recognize higher education's responsibility towards sustainable development.

Our University Sustainability Policy was established in 2009. As part of the University's commitment, we are pleased to report that we have been very successful in many of our initiatives and will continue creating new initiatives that will engage our Faculty, Staff, Students and Community.

With the recent approval of our Great Northern Way Campus project, we will be constructing the new facility to achieve LEED gold certification.

Overviews

2012 Greenhouse Gas Emissions: 910 tonnes

It was estimated that fugitive emissions from stationary cooling comprise of less than 0.01% of Emily Carr's total emissions. Collection of this data was not feasible.

Offsets Applied to Become Carbon Neutral in 2012

100% of our total emission offsets have been applied towards our commitment to becoming carbon neutral.

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
