Required when:	A guide outfitter or Permit to Accompany holder is required to pay royalties on harvests by non-resident hunters.
Who is eligible to submit?	The guide outfitter licence holder or a permit to accompany holder.
Royalties (these will make up the report fee)	 Mountain Sheep - \$250 Mountains Goat - \$150 Moose - \$125 Elk - \$125 Caribou - \$125 Cougar - \$125 Black Bear - \$75 Deer - \$50 Wolf - \$50



Before you start

Before you submit a royalty payment, make sure you have:

• An active Fish and Wildlife ID.

Log in to your Fish and Wildlife profile from the B.C. Hunting homepage at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.

Next, click on **Pay Royalties** under **Royalties** on the lefthand side of your profile home page.




Select Royalties to Pay

- Complete the payment process.



- Enter dates for the desired search range and click Search.
- Select Save As Excel to export the results of your search to Excel.
