Special Prosecutor Approves Charges

Victoria - The Criminal Justice Branch of the Ministry of Attorney General today announced that Special Prosecutor Terrence Robertson, Q.C. has approved charges under the *Election Act* and the *Criminal Code* following an investigation into possible offences involving the campaign office of Kash Heed. The investigation centred on the production, distribution and financing of three election pamphlets, and included an examination of the election financing report filed on behalf of Kash Heed.

Three charges under the *Election Act* and three charges under the *Criminal Code* have been approved against Barinder Sall, three charges under the *Election Act* and two charges under the *Criminal Code* have been approved against Dinesh Khanna, and a single count under the *Election Act* has been approved against Satpal Johl. These charges were laid today in Provincial Court in Vancouver and copies of the sworn Informations are attached.

The Special Prosecutor has not approved any charges against Kash Heed. On the evidence presented to the Special Prosecutor, there is no evidence that Mr. Heed was either involved in the production of the pamphlets or had direct knowledge of the pamphlets or the allegedly fraudulent [advertising sponsor form].

The Special Prosecutor considered whether under section 266 of the *Election Act* Kash Heed would be deemed to have committed any offence if his campaign's election financing report is false or misleading. Section 266(3) of the *Election Act* states that an individual is not guilty of an offence under that section if that person (a) did not know that information in the report was false or misleading; and (b) with the exercise of reasonable diligence, could not have known that it was false or misleading.

On the evidence presented to the Special Prosecutor, there is nothing to show that Kash Heed had any personal knowledge that the election financing report was false. In addition, given the facts that give rise to the obstruction charges against Barinder Sall and Dinesh Khanna and the charge of falsification of a document against Barinder Sall, there is no substantial likelihood of conviction of Mr. Heed. In these circumstances, a court would likely find that even with the exercise of reasonable diligence, Kash Heed could not have known about the conduct of Barinder Sall and Dinesh Khanna.

Mr. Robertson, a senior Vancouver lawyer, was appointed on January 12, 2010 by Assistant Deputy Attorney General Robert W.G. Gillen. Q.C. after the Royal Canadian Mounted Police requested the appointment of a Special Prosecutor in connection with this investigation.

Mr. Robertson's mandate included:

- Discussing with police investigators assigned to the case any matters on which they required prosecutorial advice, and providing such advice as was necessary in the event that further investigation was required;
- Conducting an independent charge assessment based on any Report to Crown Counsel that was forwarded to him concerning the matter and making the charging decision he deemed appropriate in the independent exercise of his prosecutorial discretion;
- Providing a written report to the Assistant Deputy Attorney General with the reasons for any charging decision;
- If in his view a prosecution is warranted, conducting that prosecution and any subsequent appeal.

In accordance with the mandate granted previously, Mr, Robertson will now continue with conduct of the prosecution.

This Media Statement has been reviewed by Mr. Robertson, who has approved its release.

As the matter is now before the Court, additional details with respect to the investigation cannot be released at this time
