R v Aydin Coban

Victoria – Today the BC Supreme Court announced the sentencing of Aydin Coban on Indictment 78463 in New Westminster. The court ordered Mr. Coban to serve 13 years in custody. The court has declared that the sentence will run consecutively with the sentence he is currently serving in the Netherlands. In accordance with the terms of the temporary surrender agreement with authorities in the Netherlands it is anticipated that Mr. Coban will soon be returned to that jurisdiction to serve that sentence.
