ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Derek Blais' free miner certificate number 110228883 expired on March 02, 2016, as recorded in the Mineral Titles Registry;

AND WHEREAS, only a free miner or an agent of a free miner pursuant to s.11 (1) of the Act can enter minerals lands to explore for minerals or placer minerals;

AND WHEREAS, Derek Blais <u>did not</u> serve notice to the owner of the surface of your intention to enter private land for mining purposes pursuant to section 19 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* in accordance of sec 2.1 of the *Mineral Tenure Act Regulations*.

AND WHEREAS, the Chief Gold Commissioner served notice pursuant to s.10(1) of the Act on Oct 25, 2018 to Derek Blais;

AND WHEREAS, Derek Blais has not requested a hearing within the time prescribed by section 10 of the *Act*;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of Free Miner Certificate 110228883 and order that Derek Blais, may not apply for a free miner certificate for a period of four (4) years from the date of this order, and may only reapply on conditions the Chief Gold Commissioner may specify at that time.
