

Community Living British Columbia [CLBC] actively promoted "green ideas" to all staff through its Go Green Committee and network of Go Green office leads located throughout the province.

#### 2010 Greenhouse Gas Emissions:

The total 2010 greenhouse gas emissions were 1059.24 tons.

#### Offsets Applied to Become Carbon Neutral in 2010:

Total emission offsets of \$26,402 have been applied to become carbon neutral for 2010.

#### **Emissions Reduction Activities:**

The primary focus of CLBC's emission reduction activities was through the use of Go Green office leads who coordinated environmentally friendly practices by conducting "Go Green" green audits in each office. Other activities included:

- High efficiency vehicles in CLBC's overall fleet increased in 2010 to 60% from 55% in 2009
- Webinar use increased from 6 to 15
- GoodLife CLBC continued to offer "Go Green" challenges and promotions over the last year
  where employees could earn points towards rewards for environmental stewardship (i.e. reduce
  carbon offsets, CLBC re-usable lunch bags)

In keeping with its vision of "good lives in welcoming communities", CLBC remains committed to being carbon neutral. During the next three years, CLBC will continue to focus its climate action strategies on reducing travel, better use of communication technologies and supporting its network of "go green" office leads to promote environmentally friendly work practices.


