Dear Chief Dick:

Attached is a copy of the signed amendment of Section 3.1.1 of the Wewaikai Interim Forestry Agreement (the Agreement) between Wewaikai Nation (also known as the Cape Mudge Indian Band) and the Government of British Columbia dated March 31, 2005.

I understand that the Wewaikai Nation has already submitted an application for the 71 830 cubic meters (m³) tenure opportunity, including operating areas within Tree Farm Licence (TFL) 45 and the Strathcona Timber Supply Area (TSA). The Wewaikai Nation has been offered a non-replaceable forest licence for the Strathcona TSA portion (36 830 m³). This amendment enables the Regional Manager of the Coast Forest Region to consider proceeding with making an offer for a non-replaceable forest licence (not to exceed 35 000 m³) in TFL 45.

Interim Forestry Agreement Amendment ("Amendment Agreement")

In the Matter of an Amendment of the Wewaikai Interim Forest Agreement between the Wewaikai Nation (also known as the Cape Mudge Indian Band) and the Government of British Columbia, dated March 31, 2005 (the "Agreement").

Whereas the parties entered into the Agreement on March 31, 2005, and the parties have determined that the area reference in section 3.1.1 of the Agreement must be expanded to provide the opportunity referred to in that section to be realized, THEREFORE the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1.0 Section 3.1.1 of the Agreement is amended to read "one or more" after the words "non-replaceable tenure" and "and/or Tree Farm Licence" after the words "Strathcona Timber Supply Area".
- 2.0 All other sections of the Agreement remain in force between the parties and are unchanged.
