# Re: 2010 Cruising Manual Amendment #1

The purpose of the memo is to inform you that section 2.4.3 of the 2010 *Cruising Manual* is amended and becomes effective on July 1, 2010. This amendment aligns the cruise based billing terminology with the cruise based billing procedures that are now available on the internet.

*Cruising Manual* Amendment #1: Section 2.4.3 of the *Cruising Manual* has been revised and becomes effective July 1, 2010. This amendment removes the reference to the interior Cruise Based Billing code 9 (small wood volume) for both billing and the MPB cruise based cutting authority standards. A copy of the amendment is attached.

*Cruise Compilation Manual:* For your information, changes to the *Cruise Compilation Manual* are planned for release July 15th. The update will revise the Appraisal Summary Report to include cruise based billing volumes and red /grey attack percentages. These changes are being made to support the administration of MPB cruise based cutting authorities; no changes have been made to the methods used to calculate the net merchantable volume.

*Harvest Billing System Procedures*: The revised Harvest Billing System "HBS *Cruise Based Billing Procedures*" are now available within the *Cruising Manual*. See the link in section 2.4.3.

Please note the system changes have not yet been completed; they are expected to be operating in mid-July.

### 2. For cutting authorities less than 20 ha in size:

- a. A 100 metre by 100 metre, systematic grid of full measure plots has been established and an average of at least 4.0 trees per plot has been met.
- b. A 70 metre by 70 metre, systematic grid of full measure plots has been established and an average of at least 2.0 trees per plot has been met.
- c. A 50 metre by 50 metre, systematic grid of full measure plots has been established and an average of at least 1.0 trees per plot has been met.

## 2.4.2 General Cruise Based Cutting Authorities

The following standards apply to all general cruise based cutting authorities.

- 1. 8% at 2 S.E. on all plots, and
- 2. If count plots are used, then a 2 S.E. of 12% on full measure plots must be achieved.

All other scale based standards apply, except that the sampling error can not be waived.

### 2.4.3 Mountain Pine Beetle Cruise Based Cutting Authorities

The following standards apply to all MPB cruise based cutting authorities:

- Each block within the cutting authority must contain at least 35% red and grey attack lodgepole pine net merchantable volume of all coniferous species. The net volume is the post-reduction cruise volume compiled to the interior standard merchantability specifications.
- 2. Cutting authorities must:
  - achieve a 12% sampling error objective at 2 S.E. using measure and count plots, or
  - the sampling error will be waived as per the scale based standards specified in section 2.4.1(1) and (2).
- 3. Cutting authorities that do not meet the MPB standards must meet the standards in section 2.4.2 to be a cruise based cutting authority.

# **Interior Cruise Based Billing Codes**

For interior cruise based cutting authority appraisals the following billing codes will be used for billing purposes:

Cruise Based Billing Code 7	=	The cruise net live species volumes, which includes tree classes 1, 2, 5 and 8.
Cruise Based Billing Code 8	=	The cruise net dead potential species volumes, which includes tree classes 3, 7 and 9.
