

## Engagement Plan for Proposed BC Timber Sales Licenses in the South Elphinstone area Updated March 31, 2023

In the spring of 2019, BCTS agreed to withdraw the existing timber harvest proposal within DL1313 and committed to further dialogue with the community and First Nations before developing any new timber harvesting plans in this area.

This communication process was initiated in December 2019; however the COVID-19 situation had a dramatic impact to both BCTS operations and the ability for stakeholders to participate in meetings and to respond to information. As a result, BCTS has revised our original development timeline. This revised timeline for engagement and harvest planning will be updated regularly to reflect new information as it becomes available. Note also that this engagement plan was initially only for the DL1313 area, but this has been extended to include other BCTS harvest planning in the South Elphinstone area near and above DL1313 as described below.

The area referred to as South Elphinstone is on provincial Crown land near Gibsons between Robinson Creek and Chaster Creek. In addition to the DL1313 area, there are two proposed Timber Sale Licenses (TSL).

- TA0521 (two blocks: G043B4P2 and G043B4P8)
- TA0519 (one block: G043B4NV)

DL1313 is Provincial Crown land and is within a Forest Development Unit of the approved BCTS Forest Stewardship Plan. This land use designation supports management for a variety of values including forest harvesting. The 2022-2026 BCTS Operating Plan displays an "Area of Enhanced Public Engagement" over DL1313, meaning there is no specific TSL proposed at this time. BCTS will be conducting engagement specific to this area with First Nations and community members prior to proposing a TSL.
