Declaration statement: This Climate Change Accountability Report for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 summarizes our emissions profile, the total offsets to reach net-zero emissions, the actions we have taken in 2020 to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions and our plans to continue reducing emissions in 2021 and beyond.

Overview:

- All School Districts were dealing with the pandemic in 2020. For our District it meant increased operation of our ventilation systems, which in turn required additional heating needs and other offsets.
- Our goal has been to upgrade our schools with systems that can accommodate the conditioning
 of our school climates and find us the most efficient systems to support this. We continue with
 our Geothermal Plant at our Lillooet Secondary and are now working on a mechanical upgrade
 at our Lytton High School.

Optional Content:

The systems we have in place have allowed us to keep our schools in full operation through the 2020 school year. With the increased demand on our systems, it is reassuring how well the newer systems have responded
