EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA APR 24.1980

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. No free miner shall, before May 1, 1982,

(a) record or locate a mineral claim, or

(b) stake or acquire a location

on the following area in the Similkameen and New Westminster Mining Divisions, Yale Division of Yale Land District:

Commencing at the summit of Granite Mountain being a point on the westerly boundary of the watershed of Granite Creek; thence southerly on the said westerly watershed boundary of Granite Creek to the northerly boundary of the watershed of Skaist River; thence generally easterly and southerly on the said northerly and easterly watershed boundaries of the Skaist River to the northerly boundary of E.C. Manning Park; thence generally westerly on the said northerly boundary of E.C. Manning Park to the westerly boundary of the watershed of Seventeen Mile Creek; thence northerly on the said westerly watershed boundary of Seventeen Mile Creek to the westerly boundary of the watershed of Sowaqua Creek; thence generally westerly and northerly on the said westerly watershed boundary of Sowaque Creek to a point due west of the summit of Tulameen Mountain; thence due north 2 km; thence due east 6.5 km, more or less, to the easterly boundary of the watershed of Sowaqua Creek; thence generally southerly and easterly on the said easterly watershed boundary of Sowaqua Creek to the summit of Tulameen Mountain being a point on the said easterly watershed boundary of Sowaqua Creek; thence due south 2 km; thence due east 7 km, more or less, to the northerly boundary of the watershed of Podunk Creek; thence generally easterly on the said northerly watershed boundary of Podunk Creek to the natural boundary of the Tulameen River on the left bank thereof; thence due east to the natural boundary of the Tulameen River on the right bank thereof; thence generally southerly on the said natural boundary of the Tulameen River on the right bank thereof, to the northerly boundary of the watershed of Blackeyes Creek; thence generally easterly on the said northerly watershed boundary of Blackeyes Creek to the easterly boundary of the watershed of the Tulameen River; thence generally southerly on the said easterly watershed boundary of the Tulameen River to the summit of Granite Mountain, being the point of commencement; save and except mineral and 2 post claims Granite Scheelite No. I, Granite Scheelite No. 2, Granite Scheelite No. 3, Granite Scheelite No. 4, Ash IO, Ash II, Ash I2, Garrison, Vins-Rem Ray I, Vins-Rem Ray 2, Remrey 3, Remrey 4, Ash I, Ash 2, Whip I, Gransil, and Gransil II, Record Nos. 41469, 655-57, 25483-85, 256, 374-75, 459-60, 558-59, 658 and 743-44 respectively, Similkameen Mining Division and Jessi I, Jessi J, Jessi K, A & W, A & W and Little Spring, Record Nos. 338-340, 584, 660 and 508 respectively.
