Crown Proceeds by Direct Indictment in R. v. Handlen

Victoria – The Criminal Justice Branch, Ministry of Justice (CJB) has filed a Direct Indictment in the prosecution of Garry Taylor Handlen. The Indictment charges Mr. Handlen with two counts of first degree murder in the deaths of Kathryn-Mary Herbert and Monica Ross Jack, and was filed in the British Columbia Supreme Court Registry in Vancouver on March 16, 2015. The first appearance on the Indictment is scheduled for March 20, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in Vancouver. This appearance is expected to be brief.

As a result of the Direct Indictment, the prosecution has now moved into the Supreme Court and CJB will direct a Stay of Proceedings on the original Provincial Court file, which was file number 81863-1 in the Abbotsford Court Registry.
