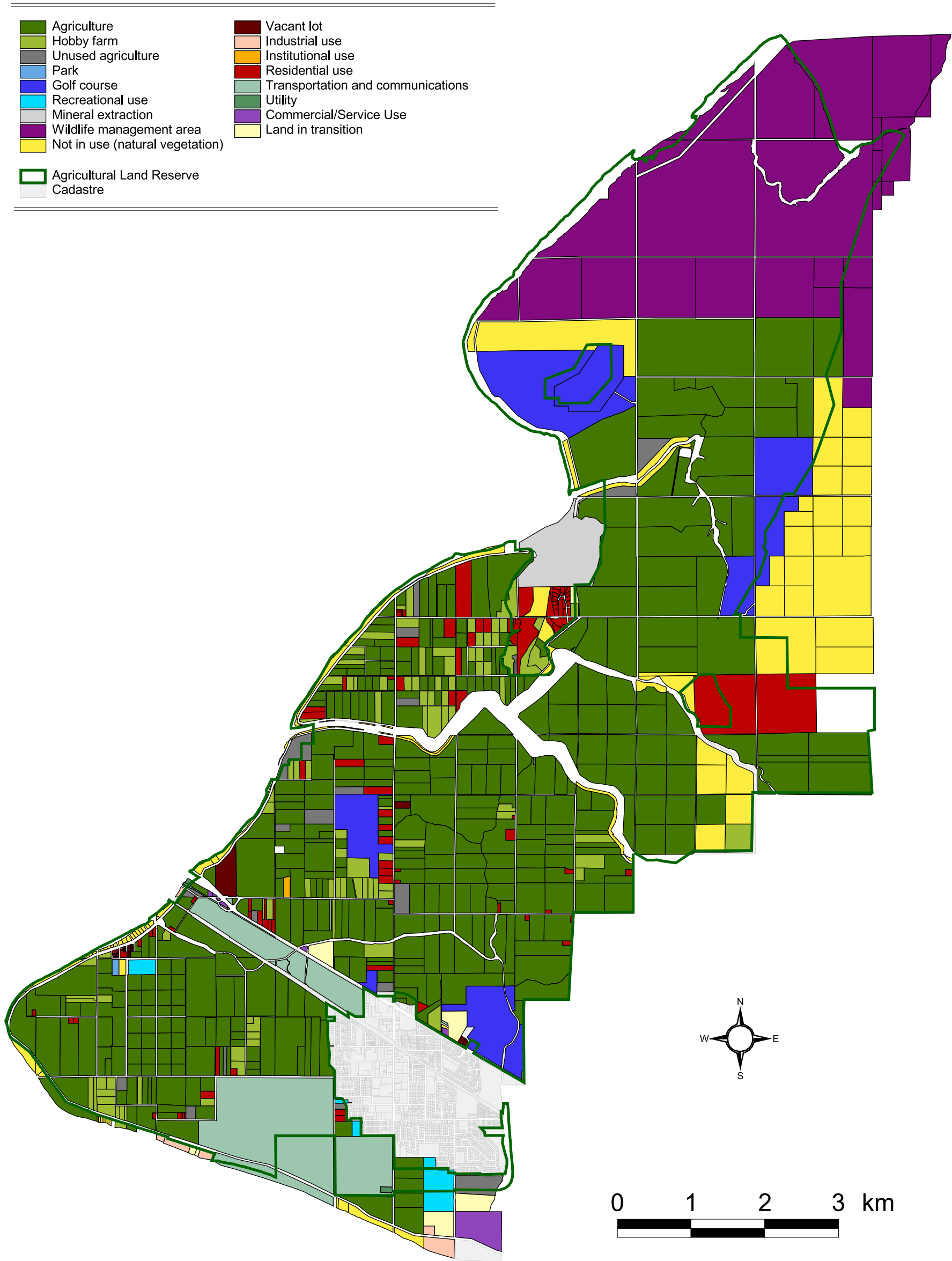


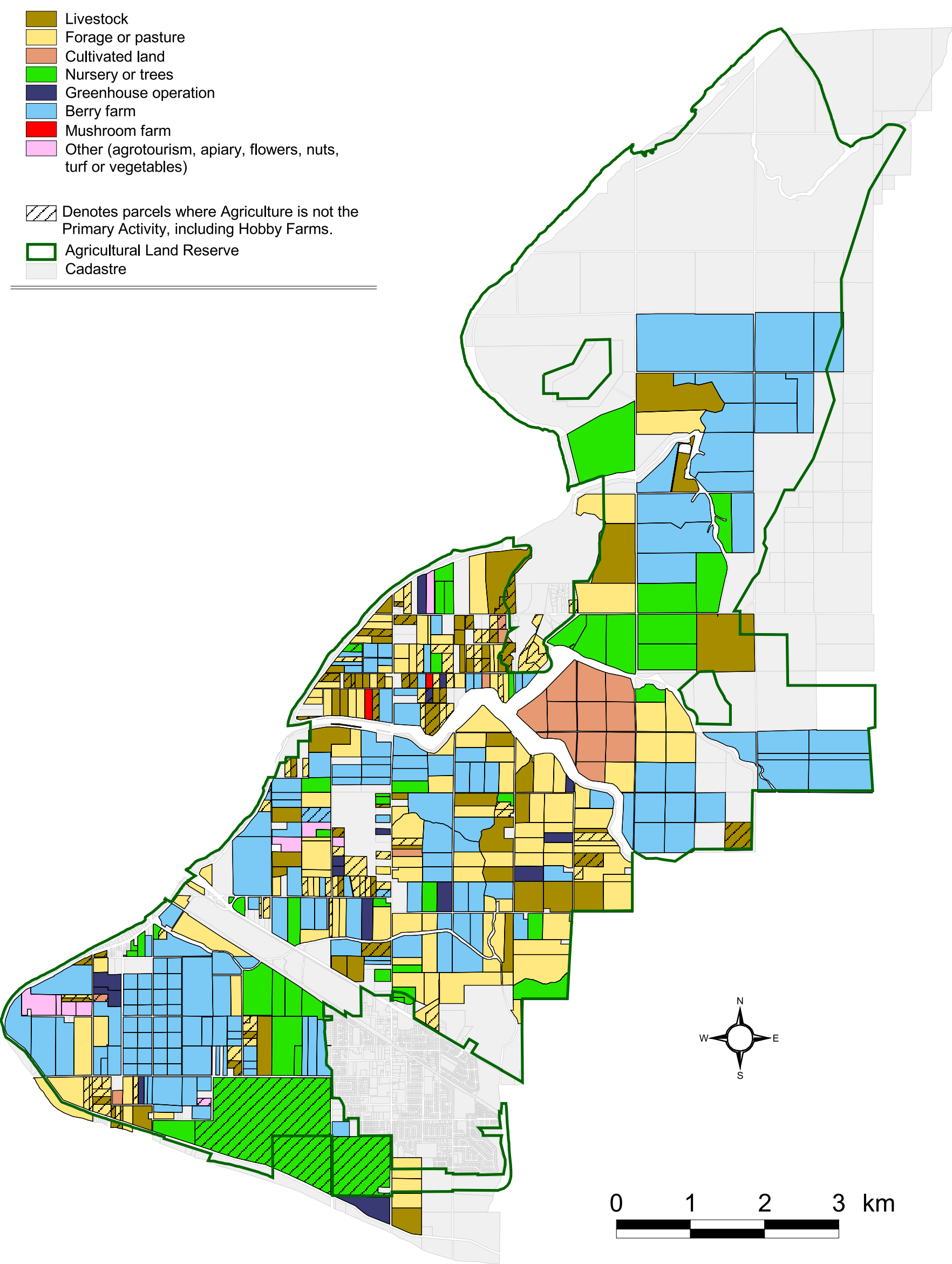

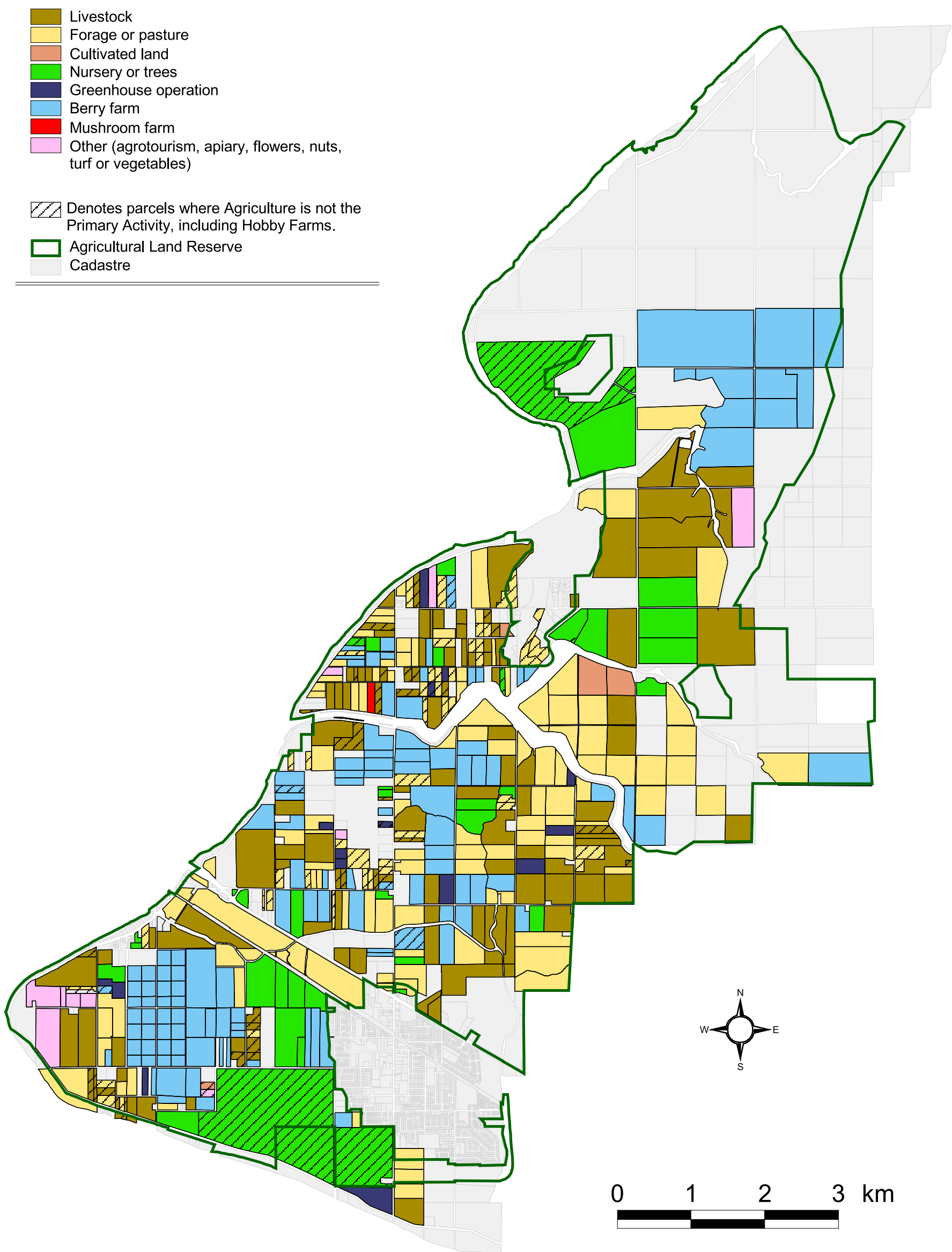
Primary Agricultural Activity, 2002

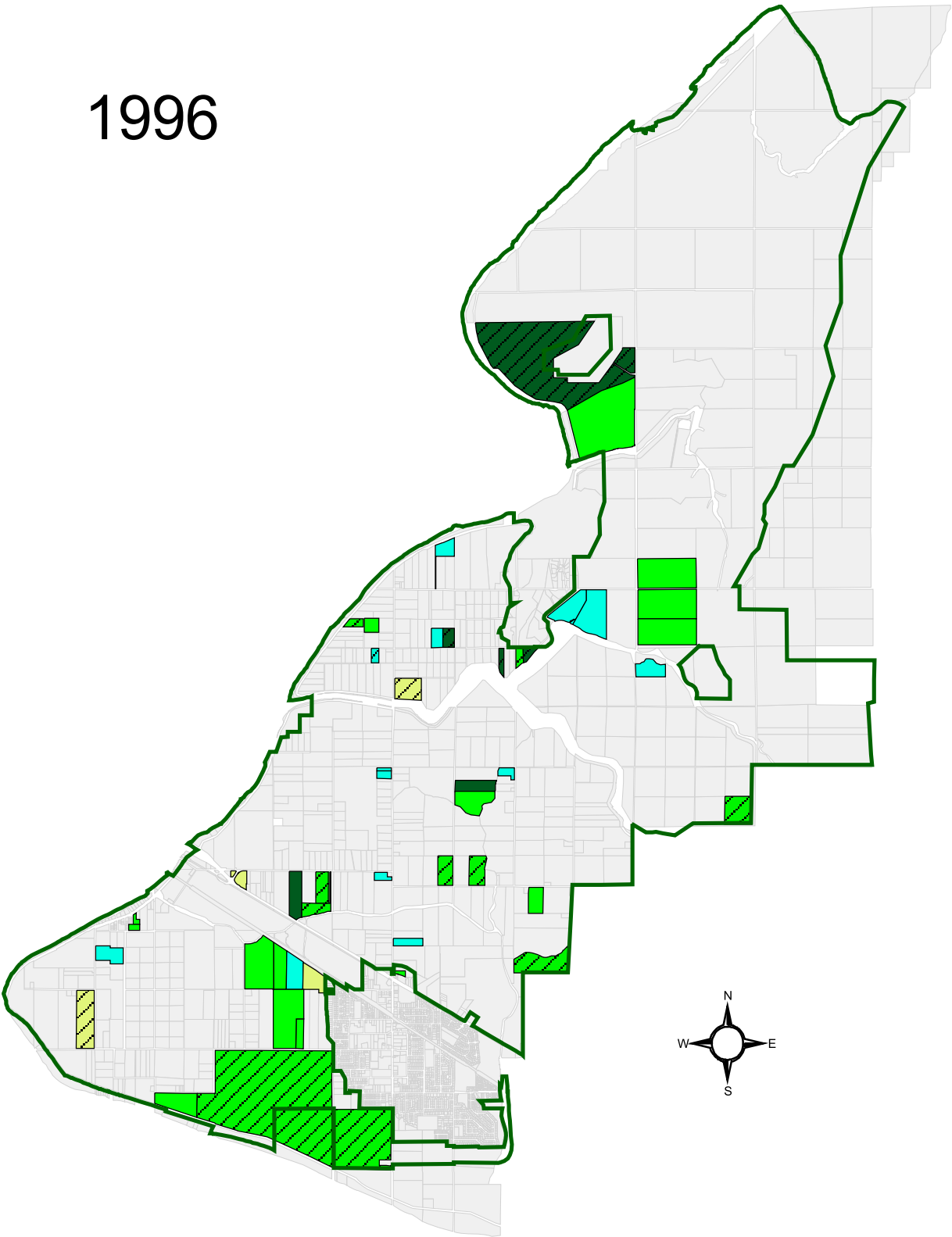

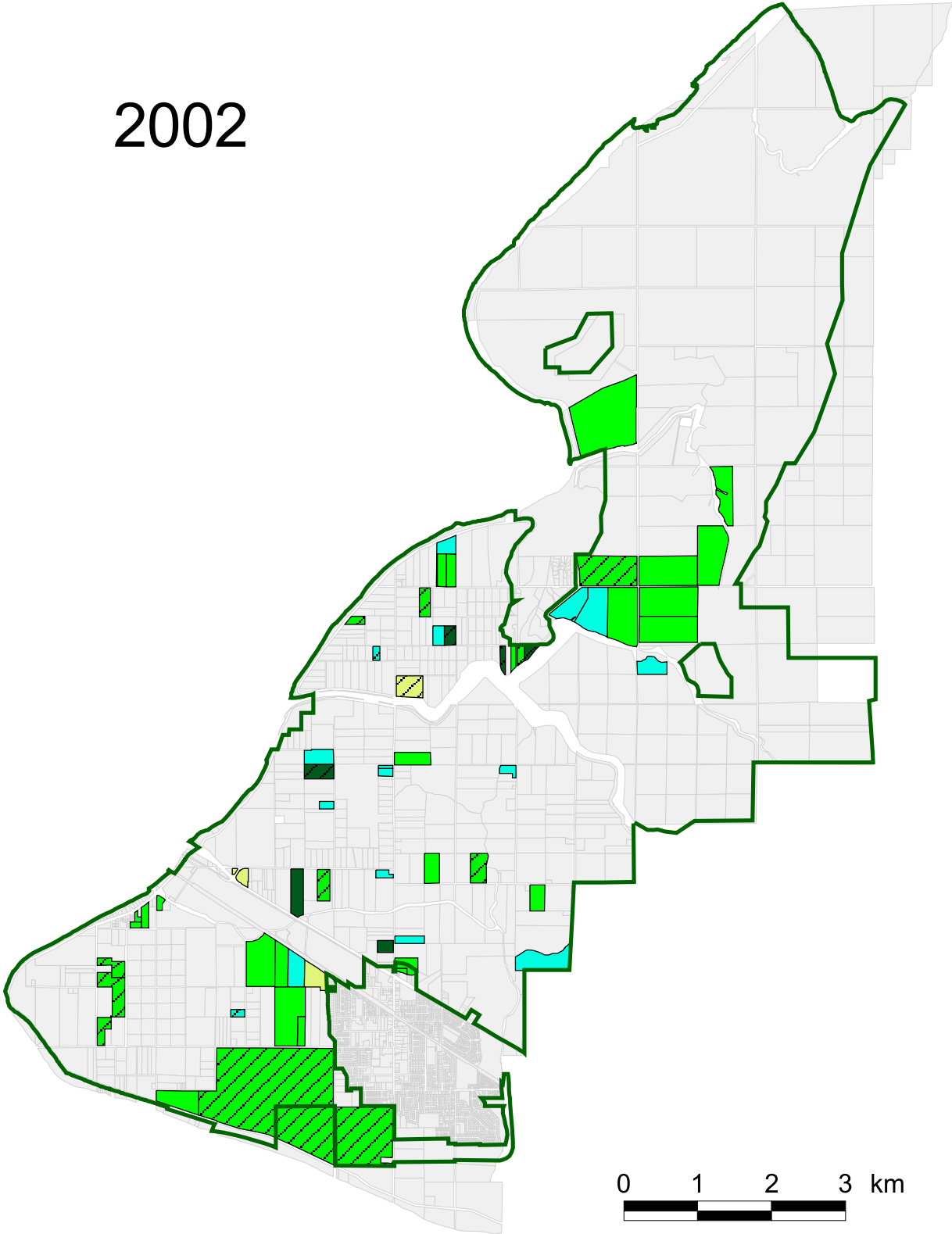

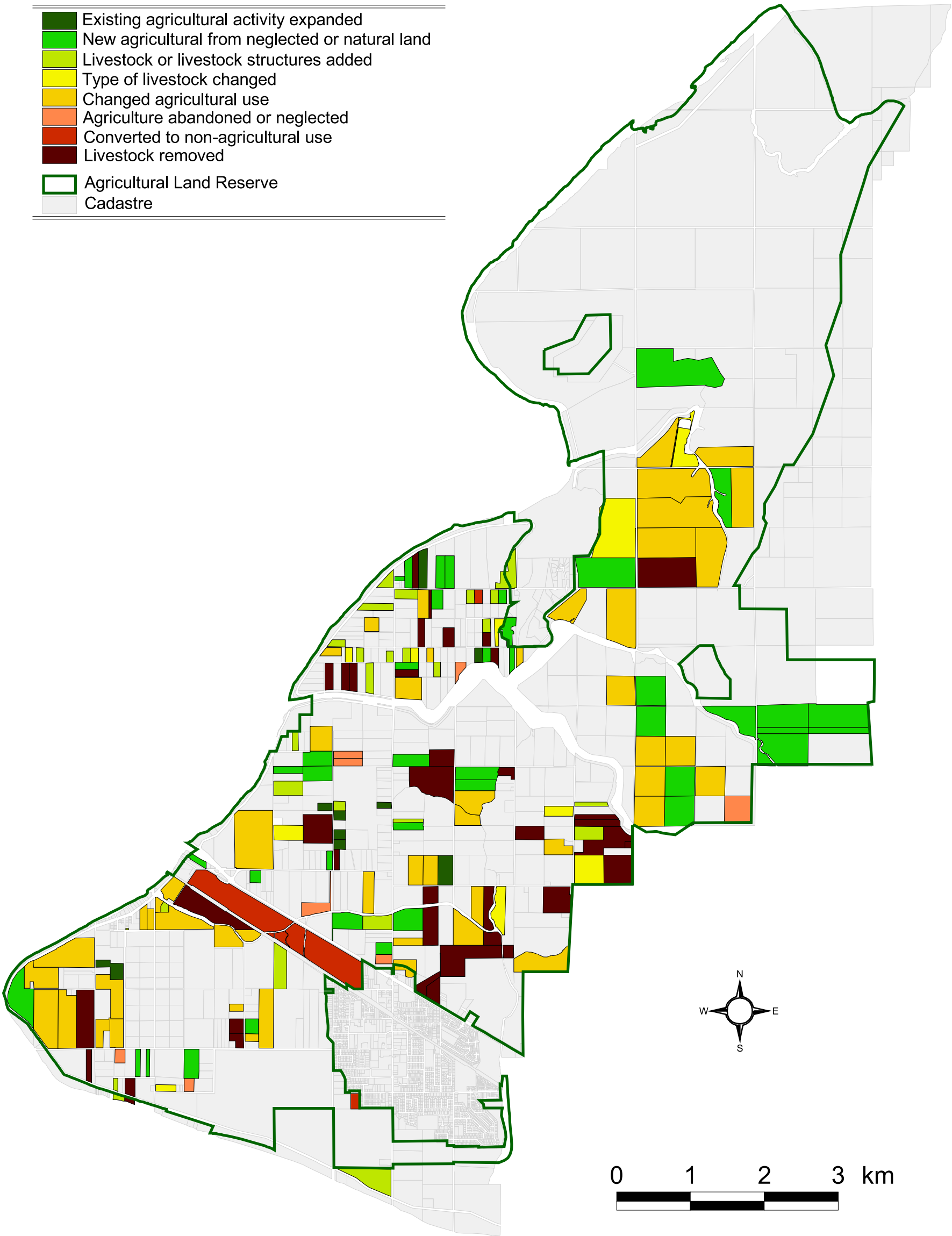

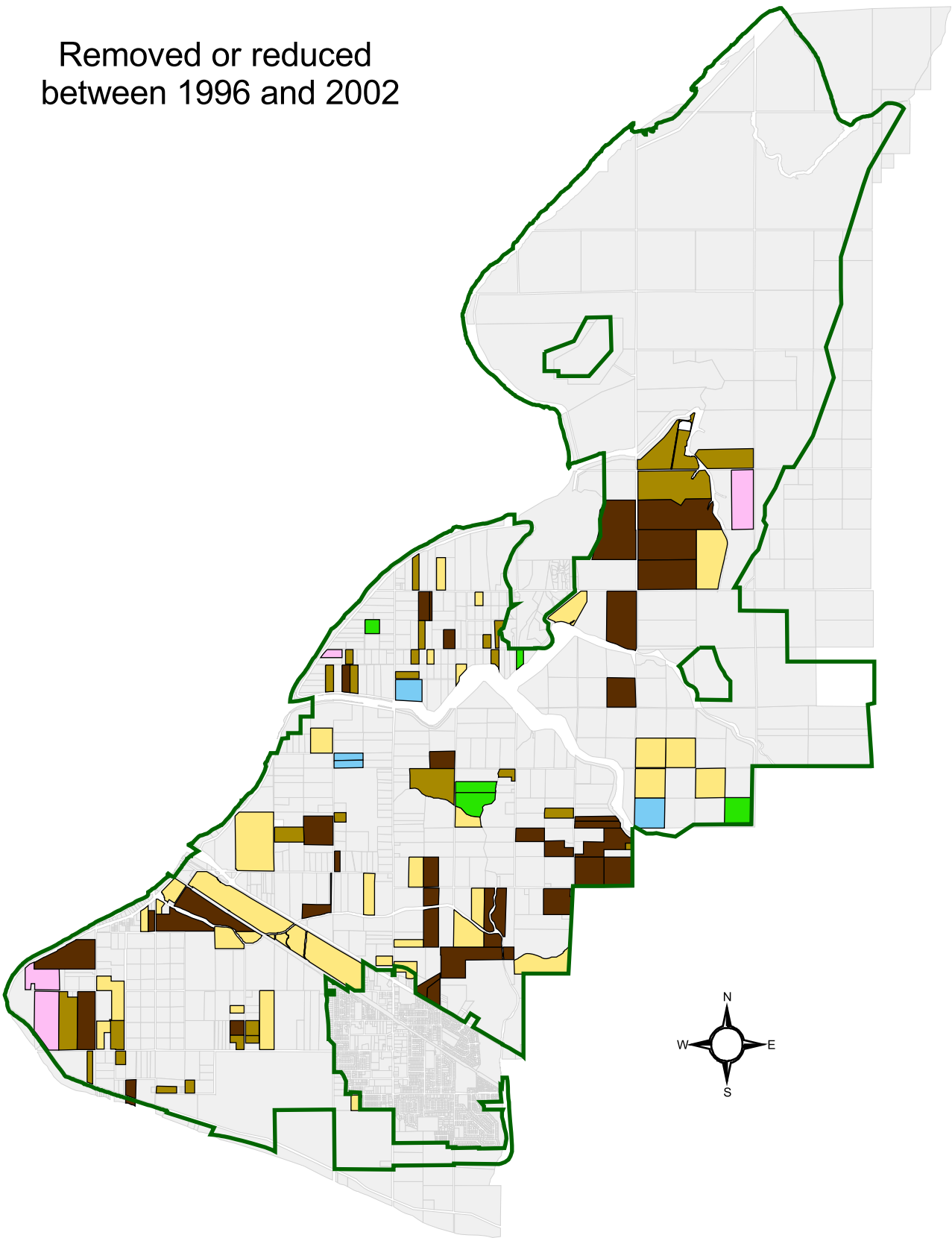

Agricultural Land Use Changes between 1996 and 2002, Map 2

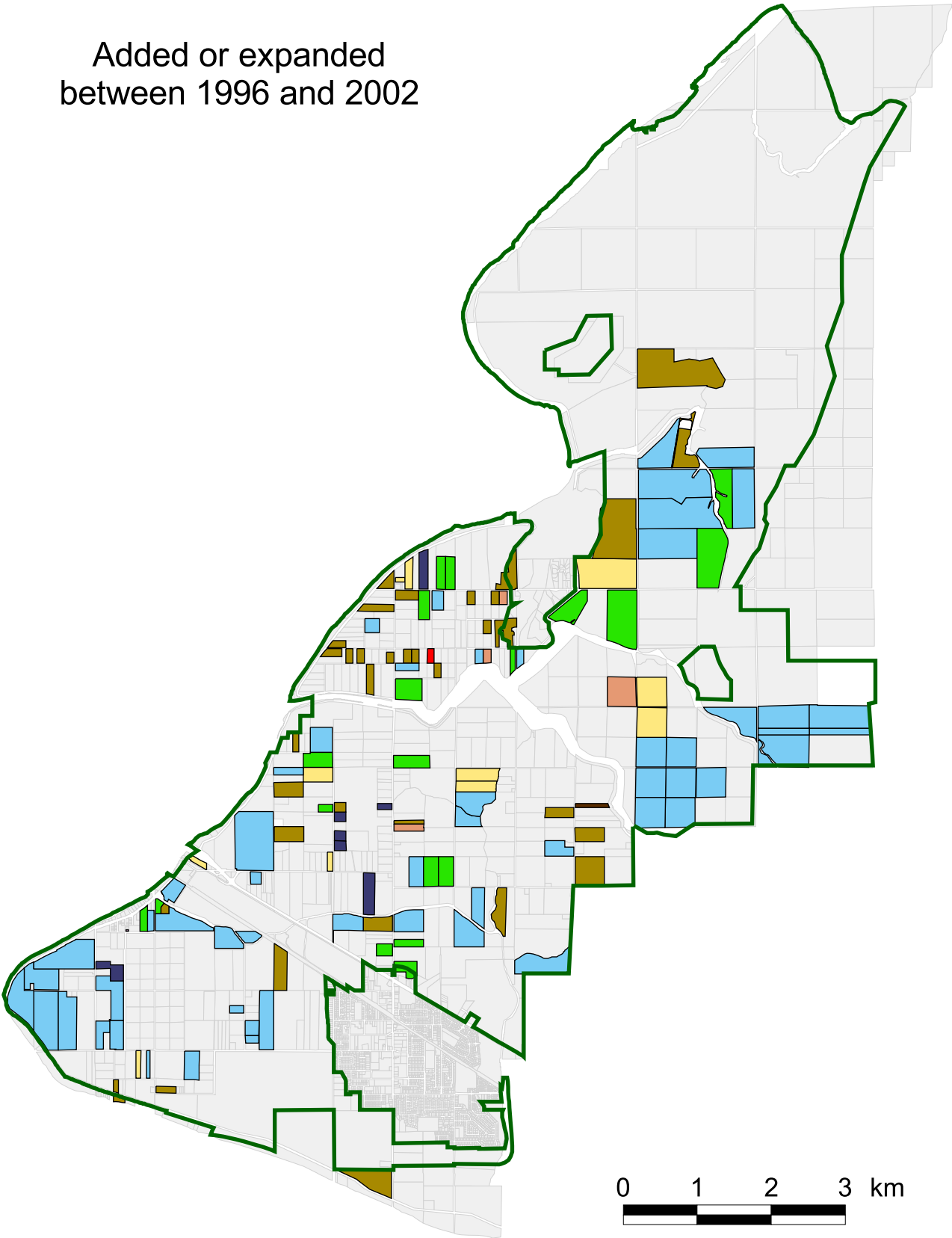
