Young Plant/Establishment Needs	Plant has a bushy growth habit especially when young	
	Plant responds favourable to high tunnelling	
	Slow starter	
Appearance/Plant Habit	More vigorous than Duke

Pruning/Maintenance	Can require detailed pruning to reduce twiggy growth	
	Important to maintain a good balance of first and second-year wood	
Fertilization	Moderately-high Nitrogen requirement	
Pollination	Requires similar number of bee hives/acre as Duke.
