Moratorium on Recoveries from Protocol Audits In order to allow physicians and diagnostic facilities reasonable time to modify practice patterns subsequent to the adoption of protocols, the Medical Services Commission has approved a moratorium on the recovery of MSP funds from the auditing of a protocol for a period of six months from the date on which a protocol is implemented (effective date as stated in the Minute of Commission). Physicians are advised to implement protocols in accordance with the effective date to ensure that alterations in their practice are completed within the approved transition period, and to avoid potential recovery of funds through audit.
