Think of AI as a helper for your learning, not a replacement. It can assist with certain tasks, but be sure to stay involved in your learning by asking questions and getting help from teachers and other sources.

Use other tools too

Al-generated content can be a starting point. It isn't a final product. Use it to spark your thinking, but make sure to add in your ideas.

Don't use only Al-generated content. Use and explore different sources, resources, and tools too.

### Use Al ethically





If you use an Al tool, make sure you don't misrepresent Al-generated content as your own work.

Don't use AI to cheat, plagiarize, or complete assignments for you. It's important to complete your work. Be sure to ask your teachers when you can and cannot use generative AI tools.

## Check for bias and accuracy



Ask questions

If something seems unclear or wrong, seek clarification from your teachers or other sources you know you can trust.

Al can produce biased or wrong content. Use your critical thinking skills to think about what Al generates before using it.
