BURNABY – The inquest into the death of David James Stitt has been scheduled.

Stitt was in medical distress while in the custody of Surrey RCMP on June 18, 2008. Despite medical treatment, he died June 19, 2008 at Peace Arch Hospital.

The inquest is scheduled for May 18-20, 2010. Presiding coroner Jeff Dolan and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
