1	 Report to the Commissioner pursuant to section 7 of the Independent School Act The form is available at www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/governments/organizational-structure/ministries-organizations/boards-commissions-tribunals/commissioner-for-teacher-regulation/report-as-teacher-school. The form must be signed by the Principal. Please include with this form a copy of the letter to the teacher advising of the conclusion, and any findings and consequences. Summary of reasons for reporting and/or description of conduct being reported. If a succinct description of the conduct, findings and consequences is contained in the letter to the teacher advising of the conclusion of the investigation, it is not necessary to complete this section. If possible, include all records as described in section 3 below.
