Do you know how to find intruders on your Wi-Fi?

Step 1

Every client on Wi-Fi has a MAC address, a 12-character identifier made up of numbers and letters

Step 2

Log onto your router with your administrator username and password

Step 3

Find the menu option for attached wireless devices. (You may need to find your user's manual)

Step 4

Check the MAC addresses you expect to be connected, any extra may be intruders

Step 5

Most routers have the option to accept only the known MAC addresses.
