"A radio repeater site being at latitude 55° 20' 04" and longitude 129° 11' 56" and commencing at a point 199 chains West and 140 chains North of the South West corner of Lot 1645 Timber Licence 5094 Cassiar; thence North 150 feet; thence West 150 feet; thence South 150 Feet; thence East 150 feet more or less to point of commencement containing Q52 acres more or less."

and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 1 for the duration of the Easement issued in respect of the aforementioned area.


