EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14. NOV. 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the Clinton Mining Division, Lillooet Land District:

An area 200 feet in diameter centered at Latitude 51° 05° 24° Longitude 121° 40° 23°

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
