On July 28, 2021, Adjudicator John Rogers, acting as my delegate, conducted a hearing and determined that you have contravened the following provisions of the *Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Act* (the "Act") or the Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Regulation (the "Regulation"):

- 1. Section 2(2) of the Act, "A person must not sell, offer for sale, provide or distribute tobacco or vapour products to an individual who has not reached the age specified by regulation under section 11(2)(g)." As provided by this section in the Regulation, "The age for the purposes of section 2(2) of the Act is 19 years."
- 2. Section 2.4 (1) of the Act, "A person must not:
 - (a) display tobacco products or vapour products, or
 - (b) advertise or promote the use of tobacco or vapour products by means of a sign or otherwise in a manner prohibited by the regulations."

Pursuant to section 6.1 of the *Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Act*, it is hereby ordered that:

 Al's Smoke Shop Corp., must pay a total monetary penalty in the amount of \$4000.00, for contraventions named in the Decision of the Administrator, no later than 30 days after the date of this Order. You may pay this by cheque or money order, payable to the Minister of Finance, mailed to the administrator at the following address:

2. Al's Smoke Shop Corp., must not sell or offer to sell tobacco and vapour products at retail for a period of 60 consecutive calendar days at the following location: 10533 King George Blvd., Surrey, BC, V3T 2X1. Suspension period is September 7, 2021 until November 5, 2021.
