
Determination:

The Ministry of Forests, Lands & Natural Resource Operations remains committed to a meaningful consultation process with First Nations who may assert traditional aboriginal interests in an area covered by this WLP. The particulars of this WLP have been communicated to the appropriate First Nations and their input has been encouraged. To date, I have not been advised of any site-specific aboriginal interests that may be infringed upon by the proposed development described in this WLP.

The term of this plan is January 1, 2014, to December 31, 2023. Further development taking place on Woodlot Licence W0082 must be done in accordance with the approved WLP. If you need clarification of any aspect of this determination, please contact Jim Simpson at 250-286-9360.
