### **Getting started**

Ask the hunter to provide:

- Photo ID
- Fish and Wildlife ID number

Search for hunter's profile

- Review the contact information and click the **UPDATE** button to make changes.
- To begin a licence purchase, click on the **BUY HUNTING PRODUCTS** button.

**Note:** The system will not allow licence purchases if the hunter does not have an active FWID and active credentials. Advise the hunter to call the FrontCounter BC Contact Center at 1-877-855-3222 if updates to the FWID or credentials are required.

#### Steps:

- Buying for Self Non-Resident Licence go to step 1
- Parent or legal guardian buying on Behalf of a Youth Non-Resident go to step 2
- Buying for self Non-Resident Species Licenses go to step 3
- Buying on behalf of a Youth Non-Resident Species Licences go to <u>step 4</u>
- Special Area Licences go to step 5

#### **Step 1 – Buying for Self**

- Click on the **BUY HUNTING LICENCES** button
- A pop-up box will appear
- Select the Licence Year (if applicable)
- Select Purchase Type (Buying for Self)
- To Buy on Behalf of a Youth, go to <u>Step 2</u>
- Choose the Licence Type the hunter wants to purchase
- Information about the licence will appear in the pop-up box
- Answer all Survey Questions
- Select if the hunter hunts with a bow.
- Click the Add to Shopping Cart
- If hunter is buying a species licence, go to <u>Step 3</u>

**Note:** Only licences that hunters are eligible to buy will appear in the dropdown list. If the hunter has questions about licences available, advise them to call the FrontCounter BC Contact Center at 1-877-855-3222.

## Step 2 – Parent/Guardian Buying on Behalf of a Non-Resident Youth

**Note:** see <u>Appendix A</u> for licences available to youth and purchase requirements.

- Select Purchase Type from the parent/guardian's profile (Buying on Behalf of a Youth)
- Fill in the youth's FWID, Last Name, and First Initial
- Click SEARCH
- If youth profile is found, Last Name and First Initial of the youth will appear
- Select Relationship to Youth (in this case Parent/Guardian
- You can now select the Licence Type for the youth

**Note:** If the non-resident youth has a hunting credential and would like their own species licences they should purchase the non-resident hunting licence.

- Before buying a non-resident hunting licence on behalf of a youth or a youth licence, the parent or legal guardian must complete and sign the written undertaking form
- Ask Parent or legal guardian to complete the written undertaking form
- Click the box to confirm that you have received a signed written undertaking form
- Retain the form it must be returned to Service BC
- Select if the youth hunter hunts with a bow
- Click the Add to Shopping Cart button
- If buying a species licence on behalf of a non-resident youth, go to <u>step 4</u>
- If no other licences are being purchased go to step 6

## Step 3 – Non-Resident Species Licences (Buying for self)

### Step 4 – Non-Resident Species Licences (Buying on behalf of Youth)

# Step 7 – Complete the transaction

- Confirm the licence purchases with the hunter
- Click the confirmation box
- Click COMPLETE TRANSACTION

**Note:** If you do not click COMPLETE TRANSACTION the transaction will not complete and licence(s) will not appear on hunter's profile

#### Step 8 – Print receipt

- Provide the hunter with a printed receipt from the WILD system
- The receipt is proof that the hunter has purchased the licence(s)
- Ask hunter to review receipt before leaving the store.

Note: If a mistake was made in the purchase, the transaction must be VOIDED. The vendor may select and void the licence if it is still blue. If the blue VOID is not available and you need to void a licence and no money was received for that licence, you will need to submit a <u>Vendor</u> <u>Licence and LEH Void Form</u>.

### Step 9 – Print Expiry Year, Name and FWID on Species Licence

 Write the year of Expiry, for the hunting licence year that was selected during the purchase process (licence year also shown on the E-Licensing printed receipt e.g. Step 8).
 Print clearly the FWID and First Name and Last Name of the hunter

#### **Glossary of Terms**

Big Game - as defined in the Wildlife Act (RSBC 1996 c.488), means

- (a) any member of the family Cervidae,
- (b) mountain sheep, mountain goat, bison or pronghorn antelope,
- (c) bear, cougar or wolf, or
- (d) a mammal prescribed as big game.

**Fish and Wildlife ID (FWID)** – a personalized identification number obtained when an individual register in the Wildlife Information and Licensing Data (WILD) system. The FWID is linked to an electronic profile that includes the users personal information, credentials, licences, permits, applications and limited entry hunting authorizations.

Guide Outfitter - means a person licensed as a guide outfitter under the Wildlife Act (RSBC 1996 c.488).

#### Non-resident: as defined in the Wildlife Act (RSBC 1996 c.488), means

(a) A person who is not a resident but is a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, or

(b) A person who i. is not a resident, but whose only or primary residence is in Canada, and

ii. has resided in Canada for the 12 month period immediately before making an application under the Wildlife Act or doing another thing relevant to the operation of the Wildlife Act.

**Non-Resident Alien** – as defined in the *Wildlife Act* (RSBC 1996 c.488), means a person who is neither a B.C. resident nor a non-resident.

**Permit to Accompany** – permit issued under section 70(1)(a) of the *Wildlife Act* that authorizes a resident hunter to accompany up to two non-resident or non-resident alien hunters while hunting big game in B.C.

**Restricted Hunting Licence** - is a licence issued to a non-resident/alien who has not successfully completed training, approved by the director, about conservation, outdoor recreation and safety. If they hold a restricted non-



resident/alien licence, they must be accompanied by a guide outfitter, assistant guide outfitter or permit to accompany holder while hunting small game as well as big game.

Small Game - includes fox, raccoon, coyote, skunk, snowshoe hare and game birds.

**Unrestricted Hunting Licence** - is a licence issued to a non-resident/alien who has successfully completed training, approved by the director, about conservation, outdoor recreation and safety. Non-resident/alien hunters wishing to hunt small game may do so unaccompanied if they hold an unrestricted non-resident/alien licence.

**Upland Game Birds**: includes the gallinaceous birds, such as wild turkey, grouse, partridge, ptarmigan, pheasant, and quail. Non-residents/aliens are required to obtain an upland game bird licence.

Youth – persons 10 years of age or older, and under 18.

**Youth licence** – a hunting licence issued to a parent or legal guardian on behalf of a child or ward in accordance with section 17.1 (2) of the Wildlife Act.
