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British Columbia export values are down -25% for January 2019 year to date (YTD) compared to the same period in 2018 (\$1.05 billion vs \$1.08)

- Lumber value YTD is down -8% while volumes are down 7%. The value of Other Wood Products is down -1%.
- Pulp export value is up +2% and so is the value of paper products (+7%). Log exports YTD are flat (0%)
- Value by destination United States (-11%) and China are down (-1%), Japan is flat (0%) and other countries (+20%) has increased.

- Overall exports are down both the total value and quantity
 of lumber exported fell in January 2019 largely driven by the
 decline in US exports.
- Pellets quantity (Table 5) the majority of pellets were exported to Japan in January 2019, a shift from historically exporting the majority of pellets to the United Kingdom.
- Pulp exports to China (Table 9) January 2019 saw a
 Chinese export market decline due to paper downtimes and decreased market activity due to the lunar New Year

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




Figure 1: Total Export Value \$16.0 \$1.6 Monthly Value (lines), C\$ billions \$1.4 \$1.2 \$12.0 \$10.0 \$1.0 \$0.8 \$8.0 \$0.6 \$6.0 \$0.4 \$4.0 \$2.0 \$0.2 \$0.0 \$0.0 Jan Feb Mar Apr May Jun Jul Aug Sep Oct Nov Dec 2018 - YTD 2019 - YTD •••• • 2018 - Monthly 2019 - Monthly








Figure 12: Log Export Value -



Figure 18: Pulp Export Quantity -12 Month Moving Sum




Figure 19: Logs Export Quantity




Figure 20: Log Export Quantity -12 Month Moving Sum
