Keeh koo S-Ooknahkohinx keoolhentem yarpnah shchelhcharlt kthlktdekmintet keel yayart yech sentsoo-weeptet. Ooth! yalah yarpnah koo tsoot.

We, the Okanagan Nation make this declaration today as a sign for every generation to come. Therefore, we hereby declare that:

Mneemthitet neek koo xahimaskchilwk, koo temskchiwhowh yatlah te temwhoolahwh, neek toomhtomhtet.

We are the unconquered aboriginal peoples of this land, our mother;
Telh kgoolhentsooten swhitzetxxtet yeek toomhtemhtet, kanpeeeelshmenhtemh, katxetdenhtimh oothl kakgethlkchiwhenhtemh.
The creator has given us our mother, to enjoy, to manage and to protect;
Telha meeas achesapiha, yeeh koo xahtmaskohilwh koos queleewtx eel
toomhtemhtet.

We, the first inhabitants, have lived with our mother from time immemorial: Yeek koo S-Ooknankchinx yeek tzohchentsootentet koo xeekxechstim koo kgel yoyort phehwikstmentem an hehastan yeek telh toomhtemhtet. Our Okanagan Governments have allowed us to share equally in the resources of our mother:

Loot penhkinh ide xeehxeekxeexmentem zeek stethliethliet zeek kgel toomhtemhtet, zeek telh toomhtemh an hchastanici, zeeh txideeplahteniet oothl zeeh noonenwheenahteniet.

We have never given up our rights to our mother, our mother's resources, our governments and our religion;

Loot penikink koo tdeks ntzespoolawhakz. Peentk kstxtdiplakntemk yeek telk toomhtemk an hohastantet koo kgel yayart, telk yarpnak oothl tdeswhoois.

We will survive and continue to govern our mother and her resources for the good of all for all time.
