OVERVIEW OF PROVINCIAL FUNDING

The Ministry of Education will make a total of \$4.467 billion available to school boards for operating grants in the 2008/09 school year. This is an increase of \$122 million over 2007/08.

The General Operating Grants have been estimated using the Funding Allocation System formulae contained in this manual. The calculations are detailed in the following sections.

A number of other grants will continue to be made available. Grants for the Provincial Learning Network and the provincially-administered portion of the Learning Resources grant will not be directly allocated to boards of education, but will be managed by the Ministry on their behalf. Other grants will be disbursed based on eligibility, including the Annual Facility Grant and any special purpose grants. Further details on these grants will be provided as they are released.



ALLOCATION OF FUNDING TO SCHOOL BOARDS

The Funding Allocation System allocates the General Operating Grants using individual district enrolments and specific factors that apply to each school district.

General Operating Grants are divided into seven sections:

Basic Enrolment-Based Funding
Supplement for Enrolment Decline
Supplement for Unique Student Needs
Supplement for Salary Differential
Supplement for Unique Geographic Factors
Supplement for Transportation and Housing, and
Funding Protection

Basic Enrolment-Based Funding includes the Basic Allocation, which allocates a standard amount of money per school-age student and accounts for the majority of every board's funding. This section also includes funding for Distributed Learning, Home School students, Course Challenges, and Summer Learning.

The **Supplement for Enrolment Decline** provides additional support to districts with enrolments that are declining at a rate of more than 1% per year.

The **Supplement for Unique Student Needs** includes a number of programmes where specific enrolments have been identified as requiring additional funding:

<u>Aboriginal Education</u> is a targeted grant that requires districts to spend this money on this programme. Funding cannot be redirected into other programme areas. This is to help focus funds to improve student achievement in this group.

<u>English as a Second Language/French as a Second Language</u> recognises the additional cost of providing programmes for English/French as a Second Language to school-age students. Students are eligible for a maximum of five years.

Special Needs recognises the additional cost of providing programmes for three categories of students:

Level 1: Physically Dependent or Deafblind,

<u>Level 2</u>: Moderate to Profound Intellectually Disabled, Physically Disabled or Chronically Health Impaired, Visually Impaired, Deaf or Hard of Hearing, Autism Spectrum Disorder, and Level 3: Intensive Behaviour Interventions or Serious Mental Illness.

<u>Adult Education</u> provides funding for adult students taking a planned programme of studies leading to a British Columbia Certificate of Graduation.

The **Supplement for Salary Differential** is based on a standardised Student Educator Ratio and provides additional funding to school districts with higher average teacher salaries.

The **Supplement for Unique Geographic Factors** recognises the varying physical and environmental conditions faced by school districts.

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The **Supplement for Transportation and Housing** provides funding to support the transportation of students to and from school on a regular basis, and funds for special housing arrangements.

The Funding Protection Supplement protects districts from year-to-year funding declines.

Grants for 2008/09 will be recalculated once actual September 30, 2008 enrolments are known. The components that will be recalculated this autumn are:

- Basic Enrolment-Based Funding
- Supplement for Enrolment Decline
- Supplement for Unique Student Needs
- Supplement for Salary Differential
- Funding for Additional Costs Resulting from Labour Settlements
- Funding Protection

In addition to this, funding will be provided for growth in special needs enrolment determined from the February 2009 enrolment count, as well as additional Distributed Learning enrolment from the February and May 2009 enrolment counts.

A holdback of \$84.5 million is being held in reserve to meet the requirements of additional enrolment that occurs during the school year. Any remaining funding will be distributed when all 2008/09 enrolment counts are completed.

SUPPLEMENT FOR SALARY DIFFERENTIAL

The Supplement for Salary Differential provides additional funding to districts with higher average teacher salaries. The Average Salary is based on educator salaries determined using 2005/06 teacher salary grids. This supplement will be updated based on the number of educators as reported through Form 2003 as at September 30, 2008.

The calculation for the supplement uses the following data and process:

The count for regular teachers includes all those of Type 0, 5, 6, 10, and 11. Teachers reported as Continuing Education, or Exchange Teachers (Special Case Codes T and X) are included, but teachers reported in Provincial Resource Programmes (PRPs), Youth Custody/Residential Attendance Centres, the Conseil Scolaire Francophone, (Type A, B, F) are excluded as they are funded separately. Teachers who were reported with no grid category are also excluded.

Base salary is added to isolation allowance to arrive at total salary. In addition, as most vice-principals also teach in the classroom, the FTE of administrators (Type 9 only) is included at the Category 6 maximum teacher salary. The increments, as reported after September 30, 2006, will be included as part of the average educator salary calculation.

Each district's average teacher salary is compared to the lowest in the province (the Base Minimum) and the variance is shown in the second column. If the Base Minimum used in the previous year exceeds that of the current year, the previous year's Base Minimum will be used. The variance is then multiplied by an estimated number of educators. This is calculated by taking the district school-age enrolment divided by 18, the estimated average student/educator ratio for the province. The estimated number of educators is then multiplied by the salary differential for each district to generate the Supplement for Salary Differential.

FUNDING FOR ADDITIONAL COSTS RESULTING FROM LABOUR SETTLEMENTS, 2008/09 AND 2009/10

Supplementary funds are being provided to school districts to assist with the additional costs resulting from recent labour settlements.

Funding for cost increases resulting from the increased daily rate and language concerning movement onto the salary grid for Teachers on Call is being provided based on a full-year estimate of those costs.

Funding for salary grid harmonisation and the recruitment and retention allowance is also being provided at its estimated cost for each district. These will be updated during the 2008/09 autumn recalculation based on actual costs determined from the Form 2003.

Remaining funding for additional teacher costs will be distributed proportionally based on total base teacher salaries as reported on the Form 2003 for the current year. For estimated 2008/09 funding, total 2007/08 teacher salaries were used. These will be replaced with actual 2008/09 salaries during the autumn recalculation when these values are known.

The funding for additional teacher costs includes \$41 million for districts' contributions to the teachers' pension plan.

Funding for additional costs for excluded and support staff is also being provided on a proportional basis based on total district salaries for these employee groups. Salaries are from the 2007/08 annual budgets and will be updated when more current information is available.

The Small Community Supplement is provided when a student population within a defined area does not exceed 250 elementary students and/or 635 secondary students. This defined area is the number of FTE students in a single school, or the combined total of FTE students of all schools located within 5 kilometres by the shortest road distance for elementary schools and 25 kilometres by the shortest road distance for secondary schools. Only regular schools are eligible for this supplement.

The Small Community Supplement is based on the previous year's enrolment. For 2008/09, the Supplement is determined using funded enrolment as at September 30, 2007.

The Supplement is calculated for each "community" by placing the number of FTEs into the applicable formula that appears below for each of the three categories. The totals for each community are then aggregated to provide a total district funding amount for the Small Community Supplement.

A. Elementary Small Community Funding

Eligibility: Communities with 250 or fewer elementary school-age FTE students:
For each community with 110 or fewer elementary FTEs:
Lesser of \$126,000 or (\$10,000 x FTEs)
For each community with 110 to 250 elementary FTEs: \$126,000 – (\$900 x (FTEs – 110))

B. Secondary Small Community Funding

Eligibility: Communities with 635 or fewer secondary school-age FTE students: For each community with 100 or fewer secondary FTEs: FTEs x \$3,745 For each community with 100 to 635 secondary FTEs: \$374,500 – (\$700 x (FTEs – 100))

C. Grade 11 and 12 Small Community Funding

Eligibility: Communities eligible for the Secondary Small Community Funding, and with school-age enrolments in Grades 11 and/or 12:

For each community with 15 or fewer Grade 11 & 12 FTEs: \$10,000 per FTE

For each community with 15 or fewer Grade 11 & 12 FTEs: \$10,000 per FTE For each community with more than 15 and less than 215 Grade 11 & 12 FTEs: \$150,000 – ((FTEs – 15) x \$750)

A funding factor increase of 6.7% is applied to the formula result for each district.

Days of Cooling

The number of Days of Cooling is taken from Environment Canada's "Canadian Climate Normals, 1971-2000", and represents the number of degrees that the mean temperature for a given day is **above** 18 degrees Celsius. These Days are averaged by month and year using the 30-year average. Days of Cooling are used to estimate the additional cooling requirements of buildings as a part of the Climate Factor funding.

Days of Heating

The number of Days of Heating is also taken from Environment Canada's "Canadian Climate Normals, 1971-2000", and represents the number of degrees that the mean temperature for a given day is **below** 18 degrees Celsius. These Days are averaged by month and year using the 30-year average. Days of Heating are used to estimate the additional heating requirements of buildings as a part of the Climate Factor funding.

The Days of Cooling and the Days of Heating for each district have been added together to reach the **Total Climate Days**. Total Climate Days have been indexed to the provincial minimum of 2,836.3 Climate Days (SD 39 – Vancouver). The Climate Index, therefore, represents the additional heating and cooling days above the provincial minimum (Total Climate Days – Provincial Minimum).

For each district, the Climate Index is multiplied by their previous year's Basic Allocation funding. Climate Factor funding is weighted at 5%.

The Climate Factor is calculated as follows:

<u>Total Climate Days – provincial minimum</u> x previous year's Basic Allocation x 5% 10,000

The Sparseness Index addresses the fact that certain districts have a greater financial burden than others resulting from the separation of schools from the board office. Additional costs arise from increased travel.

Columns 1 to 3 show the total paved, gravel and water distance in kilometres which separate dispersed schools from their board office. A school is eligible for inclusion in the Sparseness Index calculation if that school is more than 40 kilometres from its board office or if it is separated by water. 40 kilometres is known as the "threshold distance".

The Sparseness Index is calculated as follows:

- Column 5 is the Total Weighted Distance of dispersed schools from their board office. It is calculated as
 the sum of paved road distance, gravel road distance weighted by 1.5, and water distance weighted by
 7.5. To reflect waiting times for ferries, 150 kilometres is added to the Total Weighted Distance for each
 dispersed school separated by water (Column 4).
- 2. Column 6 indicates the Average Distance of dispersed schools from their board office. It is arrived at by dividing Total Weighted Distance (Column 5) by the number of dispersed schools (Column 11).
- 3. Column 7 is the Average Distance to Threshold Ratio. It is arrived at by dividing Column 6 from the board office by the threshold distance (40 km).
- 4. Column 10 is the Dispersed FTE Enrolment (Column 9) as a percentage of total FTE Enrolment (Column 8). Enrolment is all school-age FTE excluding Distributed Learning students as of September 30 of the previous year.
- 5. The Sparseness Index is derived as follows:
 - [Average Distance-to-Threshold Ratio (Column 7)]
 - X [Sparse Enrolment Percentage (Column 10)]
 - X [Number of Eligible Schools (Column 11) plus Board (taken as 5)]

The product of these factors is then divided by 100 to convert to the percentage known as the Sparseness Index.

For each district, the Sparseness Index is multiplied by their previous year's Basic Allocation funding. Sparseness Factor funding is weighted at 12%.

FUNDING PROTECTION

School districts are protected from year-to-year funding declines. For eligible districts, an additional amount is provided to ensure that funding is at least what those districts received in 2007/08.

Funding Protection is determined by comparing the total announced operating grants from the previous year to total operating grants for the current year. For districts where there is a negative difference, the Funding Protection will provide additional funding in an amount to offset that negative difference.

Funding Protection is updated throughout the school year when funds are recalculated or when additional funds are provided. These updates will occur during the autumn recalculation, as part of the February Distributed Learning and special needs funding distribution, and again in May for Distributed Learning.

Funding Protection does not include any one-time grants, including the Funding Formula Transition Grant of 2007/08. Audit adjustments will be deducted from districts' previous year's operating grant totals.

Funding Protection is under review for 2009/10 and beyond.

SUMMER LEARNING

For the summer of 2008, the Ministry will provide funding for school-age non-graduates for any course that leads to graduation based upon a set funding schedule. Funding Distributed Learning courses taken over the summer will not change.

The funded amount depends on the category of summer course. Boards of Education may report the number of course enrolments for those courses started after July 1, 2008 and completed before August 31, 2008. For funding purposes, boards must report courses in three categories:

Full Credit Courses must cover 100% of the learning outcomes for each course designated as grade 10, 11, or 12. Full Credit Courses will be funded at \$400 per course.

Partial Courses cover less than 100% of the learning outcomes for courses designated as grade 10, 11, or 12. Partial Courses will be funded at \$200 per course.

Kindergarten to Grade 9 Programmes that cover provincial learning outcomes will be funded at a maximum of \$200 per student / per programme.

In addition to reporting courses in one of the three categories, the Ministry will require supplementary information submitted in an Excel-based form. Further details will be provided separately.

The types of instruction that the Ministry will **not** provide funding for include summer camps, international students, and instruction for adults who have graduated.

Students eligible for summer learning funding who also qualify for ESL/FSL, Aboriginal Education and/or special needs funding will be funded at 1/16 of the appropriate supplement(s) for those enrolled in full credit Grade 10, 11 or 12 courses; or 1/32 of the appropriate supplement(s) for those enrolled in partial courses or Kindergarten to Grade 9 Programmes.

Total cost of funding summer 2008 courses will be borne within the existing Block Funding.

The Ministry will continue consultations with education partners to determine how summer school will be funded beyond 2008.
