Overview:

- During the 2020 year School District No. 53 had been given a different priority. With the need to keep our schools open and accessible for students during the year of COVID19, it was required we have our systems operating longer to condition our inside air. Stronger filtration systems put in using more energy to draw air through.
- We are still moving forward with mechanical upgrades to support the new needs and demands and currently in the process of installing a Geothermal plant at our Osoyoos High School. We continue to look for efficiencies within all our existing systems.

The systems we have in place have allowed us to keep our schools in full operation through the 2020 school year. With the increased demand on our systems, it is reassuring how well the newer systems have responded
