The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend

CANC. 9/C 2210/74

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following areas in the Omineca and Liard Mining Divisions:

Commencing at the intersection of the high water marks on the left bank of the Warneford River and right bank of the Kwadacha River; thence in an easterly direction along the high water mark on the right bank of the Kwadacha River to its intersection with the high water mark on the right bank of the North Kwadacha River; thence due east to the height of land being the easterly boundary of the North Kwadacha watershed; thence northerly and easterly along the said easterly boundary of the North Kwadacha watershed and the southerly boundary of the Muskwa watershed to the summit of Mount Sheffield; thence north westerly in a straight line to the summit of Vignal Peak; thence northerly along the height of land being the easterly boundary of the watershed of Bilou Creek to the summit of Gautier Peak; thence north 30° west to the 58th parallel of north latitude; thence westerly along the said 58th parallel of north latitude a distance of 14 miles more or less to the westerly boundary of the watershed of Warneford River; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary of the Warneford River watershed to the summit of Mount McCrae; thence easterly in a straight line to the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
