Amendment

Whereas the land described hereinafter is within Tree Farm Licence Number 30 and is required for a rights-of-way for the purpose of Forest Service roads;

And whereas the licensee has agreed to the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands from Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence;

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the Ministry of Forests Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960 and pursuant to Clauses 10, 11 and 13 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 30, the Licensor hereby consents to the withdrawal from Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence of the following lands; road rights-of-way 100 feet in width traversing Lot 9073 and all that unalienated and unencumbered Crown land, Cariboo Land District, as shown in bold black on the sketch attached hereto dated October 5, 1978 and marked Exhibit "A", and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer part of or subject to the said Tree Farm Licence Number 30.

	1. Purpose						

The removal of the McGregor River Forest Road and the North Fraser Forest Road from Tree Farm Licence Number 30 requires your signature on the attached Instrument Number 7 in accordance with the Forest Act.

2. Background

As a result of the institution of the addendum road procedure, the Forest Service has assumed jurisdiction over certain roads within Tree Farm Licence Number 30.

3. Discussion

The Forest Service have negotiated with Northwood Pulp and Paper Limited in respect to private land, Lot 9073, Cariboo Land District, in the North Fraser system. The balance of the North Fraser System and the McGregor System were acquired under stumpage offset procedure.

(a) Benefits:

The Forest Service will have control of the road system as a Crown Asset.

(b) Industrial Implication:

Continual use for many years for the removal of forest resources from the area.
