Mapping Improvements

Search Titles by Client Number

- The MTO CWM map viewers now have an additional search function, "Search Titles by Client Number". This search function only searches for valid titles of the map of the tenure type owned by the client.
- If a client has placer titles, you can use this search function on the Placer Map to highlight all titles across the province owned by that client number. The selection will highlight in a yellow outline to the extent of the titles owned by the client. If clients only own titles in a specific geographic extent the tool will zoom and highlight these titles. If clients own titles across the extent of the province the search tool will appear not to zoom to the titles as it remains at the provincial extent.

New Layer: Dominion Coal Block

- A new layer for the Dominion Coal Block (DCB) has been added to the "Other Mining Layer" folder on all 3 CWM maps. Although most specifically used for identifying coal rights, this layer has been added to the mineral and placer maps as well.
- The DCB is freehold coal rights held by the Government of Canada. In 1905 they were acquired by the federal government in exchange for the support it provided for rail construction through the Crow's Nest Pass, a mountain pass linking British Columbia and Alberta.
- The Dominion Coal Blocks are two parcels of federal Crown land located in the Kootenay region of British Columbia. The two parcels, known as Parcel 73 and Parcel 82, cover an area of approximately 2,000 hectares, and over 18,000 hectares, respectively.

Users must manually turn on these layers by clicking the box beside Dominion Coal Blocks. Pan or find location near Fernie, BC to see these 2 parcels.

Layer: Crown Granted Mineral Claims

- A link directly to Tantalis GATOR has been added using the unique PIN/SID identifier for each parcel in the Crown Granted Mineral Claims layer.
- Use the identify to bring up the parcel details, click on the hyperlink for the PIN/SID.



CEXT: Acquisition

- A new quick remove option has been added during the acquisition screens for when clients receive an error that a cell is unavailable for acquisition.
- After you have selected cells to acquire, clicked the 'click here to acquire' link, entered the captcha code on occasion users receive an error message advising them of cells that are unavailable. The challenge has always been to identify where those cells are on the map.
- Now, users can hover over the list of selected cells. The cell ID will highlight in yellow both in the list and on the map, there is an option to click the red X to quickly remove this cell from the selection list. Once all identified cells have been removed, click Next and enter the captcha code to acquire your title.
