## IN THE MATTER OF THE SUPERVISORY REVIEW OF THE ALLOCATION BY THE BRITISH COLUMBIA MILK MARKETING BOARD OF GRADUATED ENTRY PROGRAM QUOTA FROM LILIAN & SANDY STEWART TO STEVE VERDONK

I write further to the June 26, 2009 supervisory decision of the British Columbia Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) regarding the allocation of the Graduated Entry Program Quota originally granted to the Stewarts and subsequently allocated to Steve Verdonk through the BC Milk Board's Regularization Program. In that decision, the panel gave the parties a one-time opportunity to make a joint application within 30 days (by July 26, 2009) to the Milk Board in accordance with the Regularization Program.

By way of a letter dated July 23, 2009, Mr. Verdonk requested an extension to this order due to the absence of Kirsty McAvoy. Mr. Wattie, counsel for the Stewarts agrees with the extension.
