The Fish and Fish Habitat Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) has reviewed the content of your application for an authorization under paragraphs 34.4(2)(b) and 35(2)(b) of the *Fisheries Act* and is notifying you that your application is complete as of June 8, 2023.

However, we are notifying you that the 90 day time limit, within which a decision with respect to your application must be made, has ceased to apply for the following reason(s):

As per paragraph 4(6)(d) of the Authorizations Concerning Fish and Fish Habitat Protection Regulations, consultation is required with Indigenous groups potentially affected by our decision under the authorization for work/undertaking/activity resulting in harmful alteration, disruption or destruction of fish habitat and/or the death of fish by means other than fishing.

The Program will notify you in writing of the next steps once the above-noted requirements are addressed.
