Lack of trust.	 Distrustful or suspicious of service providers' intentions. Reluctance to disclose information, or may provide false information. Difficulty establishing healthy relationships with support persons and others.
Mistrust of self, low self-esteem.	 Difficulty making and trusting own decisions. Difficulty planning for future. Blames self for situation.
Dependence and subservience.	 Reluctance to make decisions. Desire to please. Easily influenced. Difficulty asserting themselves.
