## SUMMARY OF MINISTERIAL ACCOUNTABILITY FOR OPERATING EXPENSES

Under section 3 of the Balanced Budget and Ministerial Accountability Act (BBMAA), each member of the Executive Council has 10 per cent of their salary held back, and restoration of a minister's holdback is contingent on that minister achieving individual goals as set out in section 5. For each minister with responsibility for operating expenses arising from a voted appropriation as accounted for in the Consolidated Revenue Fund, section 5(1) stipulates actual results for the year must not exceed the estimated amounts for that fiscal year.

In the table below, the "Minister Responsible" column lists the ministers with BBMAA section 5(1) assigned responsibilities. The "Voted Appropriations in the 2023/24 Estimates" column shows the voted appropriations for which those ministers are responsible. The "Voted Appropriation Operating Expenses (net)" and "2023/24 Estimates". The "Legislated Additions" column shows additional voted appropriations resulting from supplementary estimates. The "Order In Council and Other Adjustments" column shows transfers of spending authority resulting from orders in council implementing government reorganizations (transfer amounts are pro-rated by the number of days that a minister is accountable for the budget in a fiscal year), or, where a vote authorizes spending by more than one minister, reallocation of spending authority by Treasury Board among the ministers identified in the vote. The negative amounts in this column show the total reallocated from a minister, while the amounts reallocated to a minister are shown individually for each voted appropriation where the funding is reallocated from. The final two columns show the reallocated appropriations (or portions thereof) for which individual ministers are now responsible and the revised estimated amounts for each minister.
