

Asthma Inhaled Medication Table Update

This is a 2020 Update to the BC Provincial Academic Detailing (PAD) Service's 2017 Table "Inhaled Medications for COPD & Asthma" which includes some additions to the inhaled medications list and Asthma BC PharmaCare coverage changes.
