
## WHAT IS THE EXTREME WEATHER PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM?

The next intake is scheduled for January 2024. The Investment Agriculture Foundation will be accepting the applications.


## **EWP PROGRAM APPLICATION TRAFFIC MAP (2023/24 PROGRAM)**





## 2023/24 EWP FUNDING ALLOCATION FOR EACH SECTOR





## **ALLOCATION FOR EACH REGION**







