Re: Independent Wine Store Relocation to Grocery Stores

Introduction

Effective immediately, new regulations limit how independent wine stores (i.e. wine stores permitted to sell all types of wine) may relocate to grocery stores.

New Regulation

Section 14.1 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation has been amended to limit independent wine store relocations to grocery stores to the "store within a store" model where all types of wine may be sold. These wine stores may no longer relocate to grocery stores to sell 100% BC wine on grocery store shelves.
