"2016 Carbon Neutral Action Report"



Saint Joseph's General Hospital - Comox BC

Declaration statement: This Carbon Neutral Action Report for the period January 1st, 2016 to December 31st, 2016 summarizes our emissions profile, the total offsets to reach net-zero emissions, the actions we have taken in 2016 to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions and our plans to continue reducing emissions in 2017 and beyond.

By June 30, 2017 Saint Joseph's General Hospital's (SJGH) final Carbon Neutral Action Report will be posted to our website at www.sjghcomox.ca.

Overview:

Saint Joseph's General Hospital:

- 2016: The acute care areas of SJGH will close in October 2017; therefore no new energy initiatives were undertaken in 2016.
- 2016: SJGH engaged a consultant to audit the required energy use in the areas which will be decommissioned. The consultant recommended a number of energy reduction strategies which will put in place after the transition of acute care services.

SJGH holds an ownership share in Cumberland Laundry; part of the carbon offsets for Cumberland Laundry is included in the total for SJGH.

Cumberland Laundry:

- 2016: The main loading dock doors at Cumberland Laundry were replaced with weather tight insulated doors; this has reduced natural gas and hydro consumption.
- 2016: All windows we re-caulked and two windows were replaced to reduce heat loss.
- 2016: All unoccupied areas of the laundry were retrofitted with occupancy sensors for room lighting.
- 2016: Wash and dry load sizes were increased to reduce energy use in the washing and drying area of the laundry. This has reduced hydro and natural gas consumption.
- 2017 / 2018: The dryer heat reclaim project has been deferred to late 2017 or 2018. This project will
 employ heat exchangers to capture fugitive heat from the dryers. This will reduce natural gas and hydro
 consumption.

In accordance with the requirements of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Targets Act and Carbon Neutral Government Regulation, Saint Joseph's General Hospital is responsible for arranging for the retirement of the offsets obligation reported above for the 2016 calendar year, together with any adjustments reported for past calendar years. The Organization hereby agrees that, in exchange for the Ministry of Environment ensuring that these offsets are retired on the Organization's behalf, the Organization will pay within 30 days, the associated invoice to be issued by the Ministry in an amount equal to \$25 per tonne of offsets retired on its behalf plus GST.


