

Greenhouse Gas Industrial Reporting and Control Act Bulletin 019

Requirement to report emissions from combustion of non-woody biomass

Greenhouse Gas Emission Reporting Regulation (GGERR)

Overview

This bulletin provides information to industrial operators that have a reporting obligation under the Greenhouse Gas Emission Reporting Regulation ('the Regulation' or 'GGERR'). The GGERR has been amended (OIC#702) to update reporting requirements for emissions from combustion of non-woody biomass (biomass not listed in Schedule C of the Regulation).

Industrial operators should ensure they understand the requirements and provide notice of concerns or issues to the attention of the Compliance Unit for Industrial Reporting and Control at <u>GHGRegulator@gov.bc.ca</u>.

Amendments to the GGERR

The GGERR has been amended to add "carbon dioxide from biomass not listed in Schedule C" to Column 4 of Item 1(a) in Schedule A.

A consequential amendment was made to Column 3 of Item 2 in Schedule B in the GGERR to include the reporting requirement for carbon dioxide from biomass not listed in Schedule C.

Applicability

Emission reports prior to the 2021 reporting period completed in accordance with the Regulation are not required to be modified.

Regulation is Determinative
