#### KNOWLEDGE NETWORK CORPORATION - 2010 Carbon Neutral Action Report

### **Executive Summary**

Knowledge Network is BC's viewer supported public broadcaster. Our 2010 climate change action plans focus primarily on educational broadcast initiatives that influence behavioural change. As a tenant in a building owned and operated by the British Columbia Institute of Technology, we do not have influence over the building operations.

Over the past year, we made progress in many key areas including post-consumer recycled paper usage and consumption. Our "Knowledge Green Team" also initiated a number of programs to increase staff awareness and education on climate change.

Our most significant impact continues to be with our broadcast service, both on-air and online at Knowledge.ca. With an average weekly reach of 1.4 million viewers, Knowledge Network is well positioned to educate British Columbians about the issues of climate change, conservation and sustainability. We are committed to researching and acquiring content in these areas that will engage audiences across the province.

- Web environment has been moved to virtual servers.


- Documentaries broadcast to educate viewers on climate change and the conservation of water, energy and raw materials.
