Re: Patron Participation on New Year's Eve for Food Primary Licensees

Current Policy

LCLB policy allows Food Primary (FP) establishments to remain open until 4:00 a.m. on January 1st, regardless of their normal closing hours, provided that food is available and local bylaws do not prohibit extended hours.

There is no extension to hours for patron participation entertainment.

New Policy

Effective immediately, FP establishments with a patron participation entertainment endorsement may allow dancing until 1:00 a.m. on January 1st, provided it is not prohibited by local bylaws.
