

## **Preamble**

**This Order establishes scenic areas across the Timber Supply Area portion of the Prince George Forest District.**

**These scenic areas are based on the visual landscape inventory update that was carried out in 2004 which was meant to consolidate all existing data to a common mapping standards and where required, to modify, add, or delete scenic areas based on physical/visual characteristics, public use, and the recommendations provided by the Prince George Land and Resource Management Plan.**

**This Order includes the following:**

- A. Scenic areas continued under section 180 (c) of the Forest and Range Practices Act (Grandparenting specified designations);**
- B. Scenic areas added as a result of the visual landscape inventory update;**
- C. Scenic areas deleted as a result of no longer being considered visually sensitive; and,**
- D. Scenic area modified to better fit the British Columbia Geographic System of contour mapping.**

**The Ministry of Forests and Range will follow up by releasing an Order establishing Visual Quality Objectives for the scenic areas designated through this Order.**
