Carbon Neutral Action Report School District No. 74 (Gold Trail)

Executive Summary

The School District has been working towards becoming carbon neutral for a number of years, one of the first projects was in the late 1990's we changed over to DDC controls for all of our HVAC systems. This allowed for setbacks in the evening and on weekends. Over the years we have updated lighting from T-12's to T-8's and have installed motion sensor lighting in many areas. Our regional district has opened recycling depots in the villages within our district which has assisted us in getting our schools to participate in recycling programs. The students are excited about recycling and garbage going to the landfill has been reduced significantly.

Our school bus drivers are participating in the Smart Driver training sessions and other fuel consumption saving initiatives.

Part 1: Actions Taken to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in 2008

Overview:

Two hybrid vehicles were purchased for district travel. School District No. 74 is fairly large geographically, so in order reduce travel, the district holds where possible, district meetings and pro-d events via webcasting. When travel to these events is necessary, carpooling is encouraged or school bus transportation is provided.
