Ambient Water Quality Guidelines for Ethylbenzene

Addendum to Overview Report (1999)

Water Protection & Sustainability Branch Environmental Sustainability and Strategic Policy Division BC Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy The Water Protection and Sustainability Branch rescinds the 1999 B.C. approved ethylbenzene water quality guidelines (WQGs) for the protection of drinking water supplies of 0.0024 mg/L and WQGs for the protection of recreational uses of 0.0024 mg/L (B.C. Ministry of Environment, Lands and Parks, 1999). The source drinking water quality guideline values of 0.14 mg/L (for protection against health effects) and 0.0016 mg/L (for protection against unfavourable odour) for ethylbenzene (ENV, 2020) now applies to the Water Quality Guidelines for Ethylbenzene: Overview Report (B.C. Ministry of Environment, Lands and Parks, 1999).
