CARBON NEUTRAL: THE FIRSTS

B.C. has achieved carbon neutrality across the provincial public sector for the fifth consecutive year (2010-14). I

B.C. is the first to develop a legislated program for procuring offsets, establishing the foundation for a carbon offset market in B.C. B.C. is the first government in North America at the state/provincial/territorial level to become carbon neutral and reduce the net environmental impact of its greenhouse gas emissions to zero.
