Roadside Inspections

- Reviewed 2019 statistics: 13 roadside inspections dates and 166 vehicles inspected between April and September 2019
- Increased number of vehicle's inspected (2018:133; 2017: 111) and violations/contraventions found by all agencies. WorkSafeBC issued 20 stop use orders. Discussed MOU and protocol for information sharing between CVSE, WorkSafeBC and ESB to support inter-agency reporting of service and stop use orders.
- WorkSafeBC continues to provide first aid service and amenities including weather shelters, portable
 toilets and water for roadside inspection sites. WorkSafeBC active in resolving sanitation issues at
 inspection sites to ensure safe and clean environment for all.
- Reviewed updated Farm Worker and Inter-Agency Agriculture Compliance Committee pages on ESB website, including *Terms of Reference* and Statistics. ESB continues to publish quarterly statistics https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/employment-business/employmentstandards-advice/employment-standards/hiring/farm-workers/iacc subject to update during subsequent quarters.

Education Initiatives

- Education letters sent by ESB to all licenced farm labour contractors in April, June and October 2019. Mail outs included:
 - ESB Agriculture Compliance Team and Farm Labour Contractor Factsheets,
 - duties of farm labour contractors including safe transport of workers,
 - updated ESB phone (toll free multi-lingual line 1 833 236-3700) and email,
 - links to refreshed ESB website including registration information for education seminars and website links to CVSE, WorkSafe and other Committee members.
- WorkSafe, ESB and CVSE continue to provide information and printed educational material to workers
 and drivers during inspections which occur throughout BC. Due to 2018 changes to roadside
 inspection protocol, passengers do not normally attend inspection sites. As a result, educational
 material, including translated versions, are provided by WorkSafe and ESB to drivers during roadside
 inspections and workers during work site inspections.
- From May through August 2019, ESB conducted free monthly education seminars for farm labour contractors with additional farm work industry speaking engagements completed. Discussed WorkSafe and CVSE partnering on education seminars where appropriate.
