Amendment

WHEREAS:

- A. The Licensee is the holder of Tree Farm Licence 39, dated March 1, 2000.
- B. The Licensee has requested the Minister in a letter dated March 9, 2009, to amend Tree Farm Licence 39 in accordance with section 39(3)(b) of the *Forest Act*, by deleting the entire area described as Block 6 of Tree Farm Licence 39, and entering into a new Tree Farm Licence 60 with the Licensee covering that same
- C. The Minister considers that forest management would not be compromised by the actions described in B.

THEREFORE:

- 1. In accordance with Section 39 of the *Forest Act*, the Minister and the Licensee agree that Tree Farm Licence 39 is amended, as of the effective date of this instrument, by deleting all lands from from Block 6 of Tree Farm Licence 39.
- 2. For the purpose of Section 10 (1) of the Allowable Annual Cut Administration Regulation, the allowable annual cut of the area deleted under 1 above is 1,082,616 m³.
- 3. Section 1.09 of the Tree Farm Licence 39 document is amended by replacing it with the following:
 - 1.09 Each year during the term of this Licence:
 - (a) 0 m³ of the allowable annual cut, from the types of timber specified in paragraph 1.03 and from a type of terrain specified in paragraph 1.04, may be disposed of by the Timber Sales Manager within areas agreed to under paragraph 1.12 or specified under paragraph 1.13;
 - (b) 38,309 m³ of the allowable annual cut may be disposed of in accordance with a disposition plan approved by the Minister pursuant to Section 47.8 of the *Forest Act*;
 - (c) The District Manager may dispose of a volume of timber of a type specified in paragraph 1.03 and from a type of terrain specified in paragraph 1.04, not exceeding one half of one percent (0.5%) of the portion of the allowable annual cut the Chief Forester determines is attributable to Schedule "B" Land, under free use permits from areas agreed under paragraph 1.12 or specified under paragraph 1.13.
- 4. The name of Tree Farm Licence 39 is amended by deleting "Haida Tree Farm Licence" and replacing it with "Sayward Tree Farm Licence".
